In the heart of Zurich Oerlikon

The Hotel Sternen Oerlikon is built in **1897** with a large hall on the site of a former farm. At this time, Oerlikon is still an independent and very rural borough.

Paul Wüger-Rutishauser buys the business in 1923 and renovates it completely in 1928 and 1929. The Hotel Sternen Oerlikon is the largest and most modern hotel in Oerlikon. Oerlikon becomes a district of Zurich when it is incorporated as part of the city in 1934.

From 1956 to 1957 the hall is dismantled and replaced by the building of business premises with hotel rooms, apartments, a doctor's surgery and a shop. After the building conversion, Paul Wüger's son, Hans Wüger, takes over the hotel business and manages it successfully with his wife, Gertrud. From 1991 to 2000, Hans Wüger leases the business to his son, Peter Wüger.

Since 2001 the management of the business has been in the hands of Susy Pfister. The company Hotel Sternen Oerlikon AG is founded in 2002. The restaurant is leased out from 2003 onwards. The hotel's many regular guests as well as other guests appreciate the courteous hospitality and excellent value for money. Meanwhile, the planning of the complete refurbishment is taking shape: the hotel will be closed for at least a year in 2010.

The Hotel Sternen Oerlikon will reopen in **2011**. The hotel's two owners are the cousins Peter and Henri Wüger. Henri Wüger also owns the catering company at the Hallenstadion and the Hotel Krone Unterstrass in Zurich. Interesting synergies are developing between the companies in Wüger Gastronomie AG.
